We achieve this by: • Promoting the use of acupuncture for public health applications • Providing support in starting up accessible low-cost acupuncture clinics • Providing support in starting up acupuncture addiction programs • Training practitioners • Developing integrative health programs • Evaluating programs and communicating outcome results Low-cost community acupuncture (\$15-35 per session) for many health conditions including pain, diabetes, asthma, allergies, arthritis, depression, anxiety, etc. Sliding scale is based on what patient wishes to pay.
