Respite for family or caregivers of a child or adult with developmental disability. Employment opportunities for people with a disability that is a barrier to finding work. Part of the AbilityOne and New Mexico Abilities network that contracts with local, state, and federal government to provide employment opportunities to people with disabilities.
